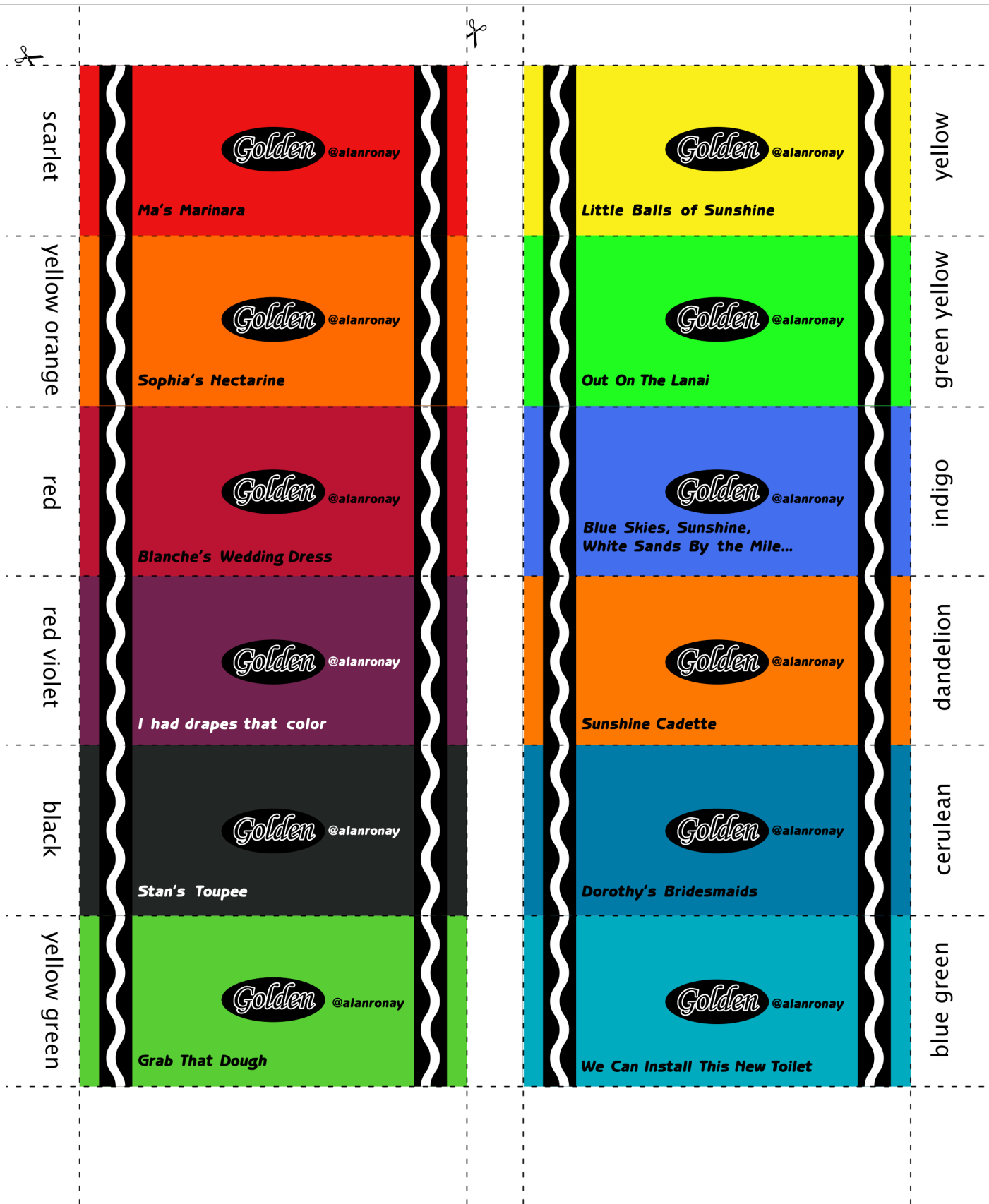

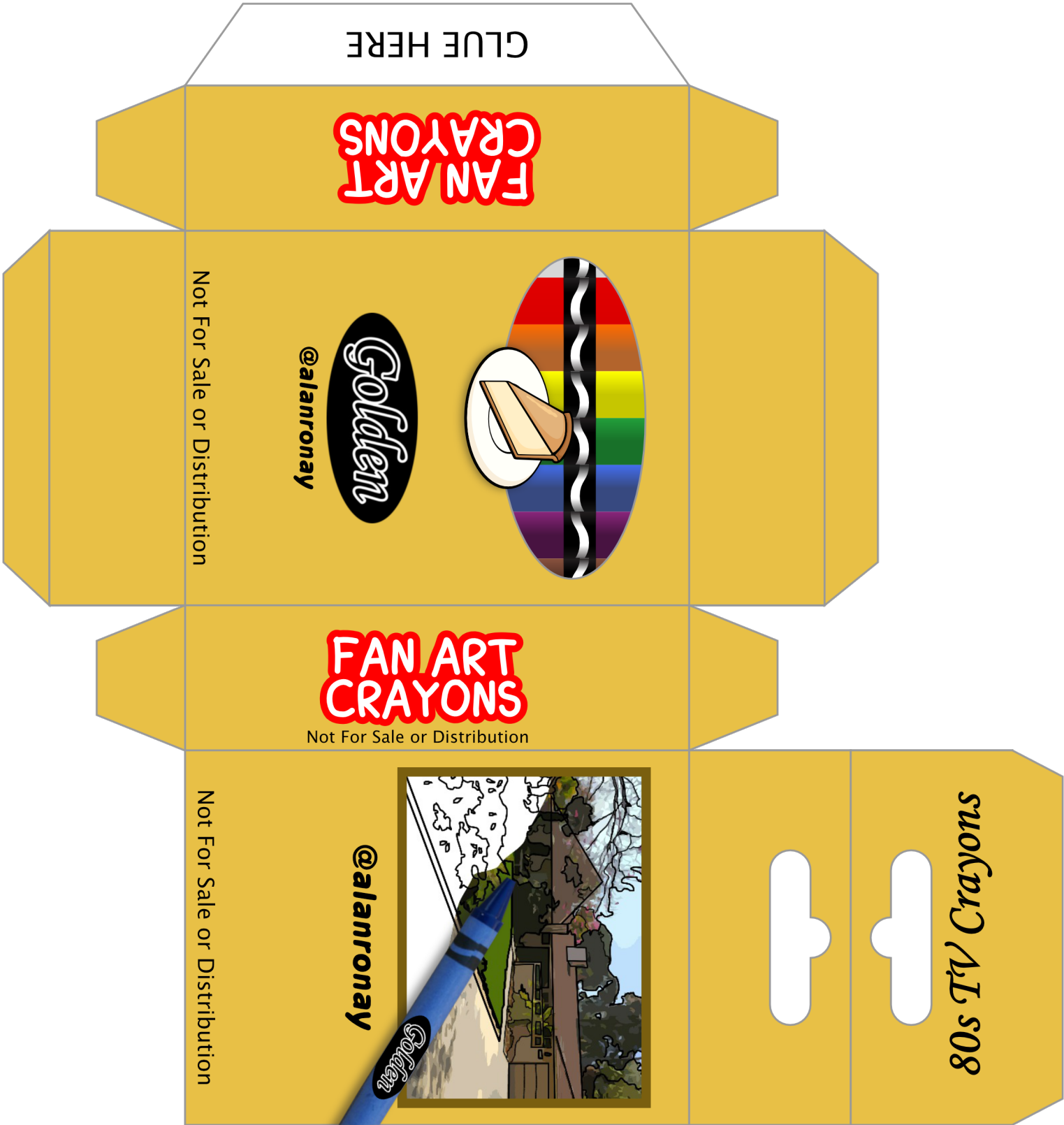

Crayon Box



You Will Need:

- A pack of 24 crayons
- Cardstock (or empty cereal box)
- Glue Stick
- Scissors or Craft Knife
- Paper
- Ruler

Directions:

1. Print pages 1-2 on regular printer paper
2. Print page 3 on heavy cardstock or print on regular paper and adhere to light cardboard, like a cereal box.
3. Cut out all the crayon labels
4. Cut out the crayon box
5. Remove the labels from your new crayons. Use a craft knife to cut a shallow slit down the side of the label for easy removal.
6. Match the name written next to the label of the crayon with the one on the original crayon. Apply a generous layer of glue stick to the back of a label and roll it onto the crayon, making sure the side with the crayon color name overlaps the other end.
7. Repeat for the rest of the crayons
8. Score the fold lines on the crayon box and assemble, gluing the white tab only.
9. Place your crayons inside the box
